12	What is the main building material of the Baptist Chapel ?

29	What award did the Cemetery recently receive?	
27	What is a likely earlier use of No 38 High St ?	
28	How many layers of blocks are there on the plinth that forms the base of "The Cross". (<i>In the churchyard near the steps to High St</i>)	
30	Where and how do you think the Wagon Wheels should be displayed? (<i>see photo on Heritage Society table</i>)	

At the present time, several buildings are closed, **please do not enter buildings, gardens or other private land**. The answers to all questions can be found in public places e.g. on a plaque on an outside wall or Information Panel visible from the street or canal Tow Path.
